The following are errors people and myself have found in the new catalog. Thanks to James Timpson, Charles Glenn, Ron Leshner, Peter Martin, Kent Gray and other sharp eyed folks. Please change it as follows.

Alabama

CG6 is missing the last "2" in 12-1/2.

Arizona

B23 beer set has the imprint "AMERICAN BANK NOTE CO LITHO".

Arkansas

CG63 and CG64 are repeated. Second set should be CG65 and CG66.

C66 in description at top should read "on C65", not "on C68".

California

Documentary D33 should be \$3 not \$2.

Exchange EX97 should be without period after "TAX" instead of "EXCHANGE".

Liquor L18b and L19b should both be with cream safety, black roul.

Suction Dredge. James Timpson reports

SD7 \$5 1979 pink	20.00
SD15 \$5 1983 white	20.00

Colorado

There are two WL56's, the second should be WL56a.

Connecticut

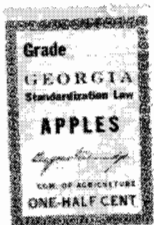
C4 is blue or violet blue with yellow

C5 is blue, no yellow

Florida

FT36a imperf pair, increase price to 45.00

a. variety of B6-B8 beers should be "Horizontal safety" and not "Co., Atlanta Ga." removed.

CCG45 should read "75ct on CCG38".

FR1 is 1-2 cent not 1-1/2.

Indiana

D82a should be \$10 not \$1.

Kansas

C109 will be a black & blue version of C108.

CM3b comes in two shades of blue.

Gasoline - G2 has a date of 1914, Charles Glenn has a copy from 1913.

Liquors - The "a" versions of L1-L14 are duplicates of L15-L21. Scratch out the L1a...L15a.

W12b and W12c should be numbered W11b & W11c.

Louisiana

T41 should read 8ct purple overprint on C40a (1950)

Maryland

L48a should be red, not tan.

Michigan

LS28 should read "95ct on LS18".

Minnesota

Bicycle BY3, BY4, BY9 second color should be silver instead of white.

Christmas tree tags omitted as Peter Martin is working on revised listings.

Mississippi

Above BW14 it should read *See BW38-39*

Above BW33 it should read "House Bill No. 194" instead of 184.

Above BW38 it should read "Like BW14 but perforated 12.".

T4 is 3ct not 5ct.

Nebraska

FE7 100lbs should read "on FE6" not FE4.

New Mexico

HY4 and HY4a should be 22 oz.

Oklahoma

D26 has now been seen and is brown. The note can be removed. 1962 wines Green Over 14% (not 15%).

South Carolina

BW26a change to "BW26 die cut" not BW24.

50lb feed in the first set was omitted

FE4A 50lb	black	17.50
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South Dakota

BW13 is pale blue not pale orange.

BW62-BW62d should be .0725 not .0775

Tennessee

CG35 and CG35a are 52-1/4ct.

Pictures above tobaccos T37 and T47 are reversed.

T59 change color to olive brown.

T142a is 1-1/34ct not 1-1/2ct.

T149 has wrong color, should be purple (shades).

Texas

C2 change denomination to 1-1/5ct.

Utah

BBM4	22oz like BBM3 (not BBM4)
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Virginia

FE29b 3/8ct not 3.8ct.

Washington

FR19 and FR19a are \$5 stamps.

West Virginia

B9S 1/2 bbl blue & bistre, manuscript VOID and punches has been found estimated at \$75

Cigarettes C4 and C5 from Hubbard were accidentally omitted. These will become C3A and C4A.

Wisconsin

The \$.25 beer with Leviatan signature was left out.

B20A \$.25	orange	15.00
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Above B50 add "**Wider. 133x32-1/2mm.**"

PL11 has now been seen in both a light blue and dark blue shade.

Add "(shades)" to the color.

Wyoming

L4 should be 23-1/4ct.

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Arkansas

Add FE8A 5lb dark blue \$1.50 above FE9 (omitted unintentionally)

Arizona

Above 1934 beers change "on" to "only".
Delete egg E8 (same as E2a).
Delete "a." in header above E4-6.
LX30 is mislabeled as LX20

Connecticut

Above C32 it should read "Overprints on 1953 issue".

Georgia

W40 color should be green.

Indiana

BD4 the 1-1/2ct bedding is blue not red.
B20d should be "like B20c"
B20e should be "like B20d"
The heading "Malt and Wart" should be "Malt and Wort".

Minnesota

In header above W40 change "Sparkling Wines" to "Sparkling Wine".

Mississippi

BW2 should be 5.63ct.

Missouri

B8 should be 7-1/5ct on 7-1/2ct.
L158a change color to just "green".

New Mexico

On pictures of beers on page 2, they should be B24 and B25 not B43 and B44a.
C6 change dimensions to 9x12mm.
C12 should be 20 cig.
Honey's HY4 and HY4a are 22 oz.
In wording about E59 change word from "son" to "sun".

New York

Printing order over 1949 poultry should be RF 246-1MM-100146.

North Dakota

C22e drop (same as C22)
C23a and C23b should be 3 ct.
L25 value should be \$25

Ohio

B63 is 1-1/2 cents not 1-1/4.

Pennsylvania

Soft drinks SD10a and SD18 are the same stamp. Scratch SD10a.

South Carolina

The illustration above the 1923 documentaries should be above the 1924-47 documentaires. (in correction package)
On 1913 oils change "die cut" to "imperforate".

OI10 oil should be under the 175x73mm header.

On 1918 oils, remove "on much whiter paper". Stamps in this set which are 110x44mm are OI19, OI19a, OI21, OI22, OI23, OI26. Note that all imperforate 1918 stamps are thought to be cut downs.

Tennessee

Header on Flannery feeds above set starting with FE96 should read "Double cross at lower left". On 1944 set it should read "Double cross removed".

L5S value should be 17-1/2ct.

Texas

L50 should be 25.6ct, not 26.6ct.

Virginia

B3a should be \$1.37-1/2ct.

Washington

Picture over C11 should be over C7

Texas

B2-B2d value is .10888 cents

B8-9 value is 10.888 cents

L84 should be 1 qt not 1 gal

W24 is .004ct

W25 is .005ct

Arkansas

B24 denomination should be .7500

1928? and 1935 feed are roulette 9-1/2. Strike word horizontal in headers (they are not coils).

The FE8A I said to add last time is wrong. The FE9 should be 5 lbs not 50lbs.

Connecticut

C26 color should be dark blue.

Georgia

The first cotton seed set should say "like 1927 feed" instead of "like 1937 feed.

The 1937 liquor decals have "Head" signature, not "Hood".

1943 liquor should be 1945.

Delete FE74 (same as FE68)

Kansas

1928-29 cigarettes are perf 12-1/2.

Maine

Delete B21f (same as B21)

Louisiana

T70 is brown, not blue.

Missouri

1920 Gasolines are Gray-Thompson not Gray-Patterson.

K51 is orange yellow.

1939 liquors are Pierce not Piece.

1938 liquor decals, color is yellow and black with red serial numbers

1939 liquor decals, color is red and cream with black serial numbers

Nebraska

1948 wine heading should read "Smaller" values instead of larger.

New Hampshire

Tobacco 1952? series reads "like T11", should be "like 1948".

New Mexico

Header on first 1945 liquor set, should say 1940.

New York

ST29 color is dark olive, not blue.

Ohio

W34c and W34d should be W33c and W33d

South Carolina

Description on crabmeat CM10 and CM10a should be "1/4" instead of "1-1/4".

Tennessee

CG 35 and CG35a should be 52-1/2ct.

GC28 should be 14ct instead of 10ct.

On L67 it references L81, but it should
reference L78.

District of Columbia

AL1 is listed as 1/10 gal, should be 1/16
gal.

The series AL1-AL4 is perforated 10-1/
2x11mm like the other 1946 alcoholic
product stamps.

New Mexico

B10 - the size should be 38x49mm.

FTT3 - color should be dark blue

Texas

B55 is sage green

Wisconsin

1941 beers come in two sizes. B50 through
B52P are 133x32-1/2mm. (header got
dropped).
