KINDLY PRESENT THIS TELEGRAM TO LEGISLATURE FOR ME. STATE DISPENSARIES SOLELY CONTROLLING LIQUOR AND SALE IN UNBROKEN PACKAGES ONLY, ONLY FAIR AND SAFE SOLUTION. LIQUOR IS HARMFUL AND DEGRADING, A MENACE; THEREFORE SALE MUST BE MINIMIZED INSTEAD OF ENLARGED. ADVERTISING SHOULD BE ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED. LIQUOR DEALERS HAVE ALWAYS BEEN FLAGRANT VIOLATORS AND ARE SO NOW IN NEWMEXICO AND ARE NOT ENTITLED TO CONSIDERATION. PROTECTION OF PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY YOUNG, MAIN CONSIDERATION OF LEGISLATURE. LIQUOR TRADE CAUSES INCALCULABLE DAMAGES FOR STATE TO REPAIR THROUGH EXPENSE OF COURTS, JAILS, ASYLUMS, INJURY TO FAMILY LIFE.
